

Intellectual Property

Pathway to Higher Education

All intellectual property rights in any materials, documents, content, or resources (collectively, "Educational Materials") provided to the Student by IIHS in the course of the Student's enrollment and education, including but not limited to course materials, lectures, notes, exams, assignments, and any other educational resources, shall remain the sole and exclusive property of IIHS. The Student is granted a non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to use the Educational Materials solely for personal, non-commercial educational purposes during the term of the Agreement.

The Student agrees not to copy, reproduce, distribute, publish, display, perform, modify, create derivative works from, transmit, or in any way exploit any part of the Educational Materials, except as expressly permitted under this Agreement or with the prior written consent of IIHS. The Student further agrees to respect any copyright notices, trademarks, and other proprietary rights notices affixed to or contained within the Educational Materials.

In the event of any creation, invention, or discovery made by the Student during the term of the Agreement that utilizes or incorporates IIHS's Educational Materials, such intellectual property shall be considered a work made for hire and shall be the sole and exclusive property of IIHS, unless otherwise agreed in writing between IIHS and the Student.
