

Student Conduct and Discipline

Pathway to Higher Education

The Student agrees to adhere to the highest standards of conduct and discipline during their enrollment at IIHS. This includes, but is not limited to, respecting the rights and dignity of fellow Students, faculty, and staff; complying with all IIHS policies, procedures, and regulations; maintaining academic integrity in all coursework and examinations; and upholding the values and reputation of IIHS both within and outside the institution's premises.

Failure to comply with these standards may result in disciplinary action, up to and including suspension or expulsion from IIHS, in accordance with IIHS 's disciplinary procedures. Such actions may also affect the Student's status with respect to their Tuition Fees and eligibility under the Refund Policy for Tuition and Fees. The specific consequences of any disciplinary action will be determined based on the nature and severity of the misconduct, as well as any previous instances of misconduct by the Student.

The Student acknowledges that they have been made aware of IIHS 's policies and procedures regarding conduct and discipline at the time of their enrollment and agrees to review these documents regularly to ensure ongoing compliance.
